

Good Evening (November 16, 2020) Cmdr. Engard, ECOMC Brd and my fellow members:

The Board of Directors of the East Cooper Outboard Beneficent Group, Inc. held its annual meeting on Wednesday, November 4th, 2020. The following members were present, Momeier, Clifford, Engard, Sottile, Lapierre, Darby, Kerr, Gourdin, Jenkins & Bouchelle.

Minutes from the 2019-2020 Annual Meeting were approved.

The BG Board discussed & approved the 2020 proposed Amended & Restated By-laws of the corporation. Major Changes as follows:

- > Members become Directors.
- Directors are limited to 9 in lieu of 12. Our current board was made up of 10 members. New By-laws reduces to 9. As a result, Kirk Darby volunteered to resign from the Board.

I would like to take this opportunity on behalf of the BG Board & ECOMC Membership to thank Kirk for seven years of service to the BG, you provided valuable input & guidance on how the Beneficent Group could better serve the charities in our local community that depend on our donations. We are disappointed he is stepping down, but he can be proud of the benevolent work you & this Board have done over the years on behalf of the ECOMC membership.

Officers – President, V. President, Secretary & Treasure, in lieu of a Chairman & V. Chairman. The following Officers were appointed to serve one a one-year term:

President: Chris Momeier
Vice-president: Dave Clifford
Secretary: Nick Sottile
Treasurer: Chris Momeier

Directors will now have staggered terms ranging from 1-3 years. The following Directors & Terms were recommended & presented to the ECOMC Board for approval.

One year: Cmdr. Engard, John Gourdin and Wally Jenkins Two years: David Bouchelle, Brad Kerr, and Luke Lapierre Three years: David Clifford, Chris Momeier and Nick Sottile

The BG IRS Tax return has not been filed but will before the December 31, 2020 deadline.

The BG Directors & Officers Policy was renewed for 2020.

BG Financials, P&L, Checking & Deposit summary were reviewed & approved. The 2020 – 2021 Balance for distribution - \$810.80 Carry-over + \$49,623.58 (Lease \$11,307.35 + TK Sht \$38,316.23) - \$558 (D&O) = \$49,876.38

We reviewed the donor history from 1998 thru 2019. To date the ECOBG on behalf of the ECOMC membership has donated \$433,800 to local charities in the Tri-County area, you all should be proud of this.

The BG Board discuss & approved the following charitable distributions for this fiscal year.

- Total Approved \$49,876.38.
- Withhold \$1,000 to cover expenses & contingencies.
- ➤ With this year's TK Shoot canceled due to pandemic we are donating \$30,000 of the available funds leaving \$18,876.38 for distribution next year. (When combined with next year's lease payment of \$11,590.04 we will have \$30,468.00 to give away next year.)
